Experience Incredible India at the 7th WFDYS Junior Camp! The Youth Association of the Deaf (India) – YADI, is proud to host the 7th WFDYS Junior Camp in India. The camp will be held at the Shangri-la Jungle Resort in Karnataka, India, from 15th – 21st November 2021, and is open to young deaf teenagers falling within the age group of 13-17 years.

The 7th WFDYS Junior Camp offers deaf junior campers a platform to meet and network with peers from different countries and experience their unique cultures against the backdrop of the exceptional natural beauty of India. The theme of the 7th WFDYS Junior Camp is **Explore Your Hidden Talent** which aims to emphasize and strengthen the persona of each deaf junior camper. The camp provides an opportunity for young deaf juniors to gain **inspiration** from deaf role models who have had the determination and grit to overcome the many challenges in life and achieve their goals. The various activities of the camp encourage the junior deaf campers to **introspect** within themselves and to realize their positive traits, potentials, strengths and weaknesses, and help discover ways to overcome challenges to make a positive **impact** in their personal lives and in society in general. The activities of the camp are designed in line with the theme with the following objectives:

- Gain inspiration from role models
- Introspect and explore their hidden talents
- Appreciate and respect life
- Understand their Rights
- Network building and culture exchange
- Instil leadership qualities
- Instil positive attitudes
- Problem solving skills
- Understand climate change and ways to resolve it





Invariably, deaf individuals discover their hidden talents much later in life, as they often don't have the opportunity to learn from Deaf role models during their early years. The camp provides a safe haven for deaf juniors to share and draw inspiration from others, learn to work as a team and enjoy the feeling of camaraderie and solidarity.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

The camp is open to all Deaf Juniors in the age group of 13 – 17 years. A maximum of two deaf juniors with one leader (Deaf) per country can participate in the camp. However, if there is space available, we may accept more than two Deaf Juniors per country. Deaf Associations/Deaf Youth Associations/Sections are responsible for the screening and selection of prospective Deaf Juniors and accompanying Leader (Deaf) before sending in their registrations. Please note that registrations are accepted only through the respective Deaf Associations/Deaf Youth Associations/Sections of your country.




CAMP LOCATION
